The mateship and camaraderie through each of our patrol groups makes patrolling a pleasure for all of our members and is a credit to you all. We have maintained 11 patrol groups this season captained by Scott Gilbert, Ray Deighton, Scott Dorries, Beau Bailey, Matthew Arthur, Garry Finch, Dylan Magee, Scott Burgess / Steve Schaeche, Peter Fenelon, Jared Pickett / Andrew Walker and Nathalie Hannay.

A special thank you to our co-vice club captains this season Nathalie Hannay and Kyal Thornton, and our IRB captain Jack Lund for all of their hard work and support during the season particularly during the busy Christmas / New Year period. I have relied on their support and assistance throughout the season and they have always been there to keep everything on track. In addition to everything else Jack Lund also completed over 100 patrol hours this season,

Belinda Macpherson was the Tallebudgera SLSC candidate for the Surf Life Saving Qld "Surf Woman of the Year" (Swoty) Program. The Surf Woman of the Year 2023 program entrants are responsible for representing the movement in promoting surf safety, fundraising, and the important role of Surf Life Saving in the wider community. The program features learning and development opportunities to benefit each entrant and their respective clubs.

The 2022/23 season was a very good season for the Tallebudgera Nippers.

This committee dedicates their time and effort during the season which significantly helped make the season what it was.

It is a huge effort, but very rewarding, to run Nippers every Sunday. It takes an army of up to 40-50 people to make it happen. We have uniform shop coordinators, Age Managers, Water Safety, parents who set up and pack up the beach, parents and grandparents on the BBQ and so many other little jobs being done to make our Nipper Sundays successful and safe.

This season began with another high number of Nippers, with nearly 400 junior members.

This is a great vote of confidence for Talle and was terrific to see, but it caused at times its own headaches in managing such large numbers. I must acknowledge our entire JAC team for tackling this problem and managing what we were dealt with, with organising Carnivals and other events throughout the season. We started the season well and very much on the front foot moving on from last year.



Training started early August, in freezing conditions. This is testament to all involved for such dedication and passion. The season continued with all the usual mid-week training and extra sessions being undertaken by our dedicated nippers. We also had beach training / strength and conditioning plus the very popular Saturday morning Iron sessions. Carnivals started early in the season with the Coolangatta Gold then we had Gold Coast City Titles, Cudgen Classic, Branch competitions and ultimately the State Titles. I would like to thank our coaches, Head Coach Andrew Murfet who was assisted by Courtney Hancock and Beach specialist Wendy Hart who had a great season coaching.

I would like to also acknowledge the huge efforts and guidance of Skye Bond & Scott Gilbert, who continued to lead the way with running our U6 & U7 program that helps our younger Nippers with their introduction to surf skills.

These carnivals give our nippers the opportunity to see what competing is all about and to compare themselves to their peers from other clubs. We had a very successful Branch carnival that was held at Bilinga SLSC with some exceptional stand-out performances with competitors qualifying for the State Titles.

Everyone was looking forward to the showcase event, the State Titles at Mooloolaba SLSC, where we produced so many great performances and medals from our 34 Nipper athletes.

Gold and Silver medals at that level are remarkable and a testament to the Coaches.

Well done to all for such great results and to all those that competed throughout the season.

Our season was full of highs and lows gaining valuable experiences along the way.

The season concluded with an end-of-season Awards night and some very deserving award winners as I mentioned on the night. It was a great season and I would like to thank everyone involved for another successful season once again at Tallebudgera SLSC.

Chief Training Officer's Report

This past season has been a very busy, stressful but productive one from a training point of view, with something happening on almost every weekend since the season started, we also ran a Bronze course commencing in August which was assessed the Sunday of our first weekend back on patrol. We ran 5 Bronze/SRC courses, at least 2 IRB combined courses, 4 Proficiencies, an off-season IRB morning & a couple of late proficiencies this year, which combined meant we gained 25 new Bronzes, 15 SRCs, 31 First Aid, 25 ART, 14 IRB Crew, 7 IRB Drivers & 3 Patrol Captain Awards.

The Emergency Care awards: ART, First Aid & CPR were all run by Richard or Branch-run courses at various clubs as it is not possible to run these as well as the other above-mentioned courses which were usually run over multiple weekends & sometimes overlapped with other courses because the Sports Calendar is so tight. Each year I have to advise Branch of our Proficiency days in April/May before we have access to the final Calendar for the next season so inevitably, some dates will clash & they did.

Unfortunately, the trend towards education & training at Talle needs to be given more focus-we need more Trainers but we all only have so much time, plus our Jobs & Family to share around & time is the enemy. Being part of an RTO has its challenges too but it's hard



to find the middle ground & each year we ask more of our volunteers, particularly our Trainers. Too

few members realise what is typically involved in running Bronze/IRB courses or even Proficiencies & there are not enough of us to cover everything so inevitably mistakes will be made. I'm not sure what the answer is but solutions need to be made soon, either at the Club, Branch or State level, otherwise we will lose these valuable & under recognised people.

The good news is I had fantastic help from our few Trainers who bent over backwards trying to help myself & the Club so a huge thank you to Richard, Jamie, and Steve from Rainbow SLSC & Steve Schaeche - as well of course those who assisted as Drivers or Water Safety of which there are too many to list without missing someone but you know who you are! Finally, a big thank you to General Manager Dermot who not only helped to feed us on some courses but who has our backs as well. Enjoy your break.

Coach's Report

After a significant change at the club at the end of last season, I was offered the opportunity to step into a role I've been working towards for over 10 years: becoming a Head Coach. It is a true honour for me to assume this position, and one that I am committed to giving my 100% best effort. I hope this marks the beginning of a long tenure for me and positive rebuild of the senior surf sports program here at Tallebudgera.

Our largest age group consisted of the U17s, and at the beginning of the season, we had 8 girls venturing into the completely new skill of ski paddling. For those who have never sat in a ski before these pieces of equipment are extremely difficult to master, let alone stay balanced in. Teaching them the paddling technique, as well as the skills required for paddling in the surf and catching waves, proved to be one of the most enjoyable experiences of the season. We had plenty of fun and laughter along the way. Moving forward, a few of these girls will continue their ski training, aiming to further their journey towards mastering the art of ski paddling. Witnessing their progress in the future will be a delight to see and will be a great addition to the future of the Tallebudgera senior squad (photo below).

One of the standout events on our surf sports calendar this season was the Coolangatta Gold. This prestigious, multi discipline endurance event attracts a large number of individuals and teams to compete every season. Representing Tallebudgera, we had two mixed teams competing in the 20km short course relay.

Next season, we plan to field more teams in this event and are also training individuals



over the winter months to compete in the solo event. The Coolangatta Gold remains a key focus for us and our pre-season training, and we are excited to continue to participate and strive for further success in the future.

I am deeply passionate about the development of our senior squad, and a vital aspect of this is competing in prominent carnivals throughout the season. The Summer of Surf stands out as the biggest carnivals outside of States/Aussies, attracting top-notch competitors from across the country. Last December, we took a small group to Alexandra Headland to compete in one of these events, where they had the opportunity to test themselves against a national level field.

Moving forward, we are eager to increase our participation in these carnivals and are considering interstate trips for similar events. 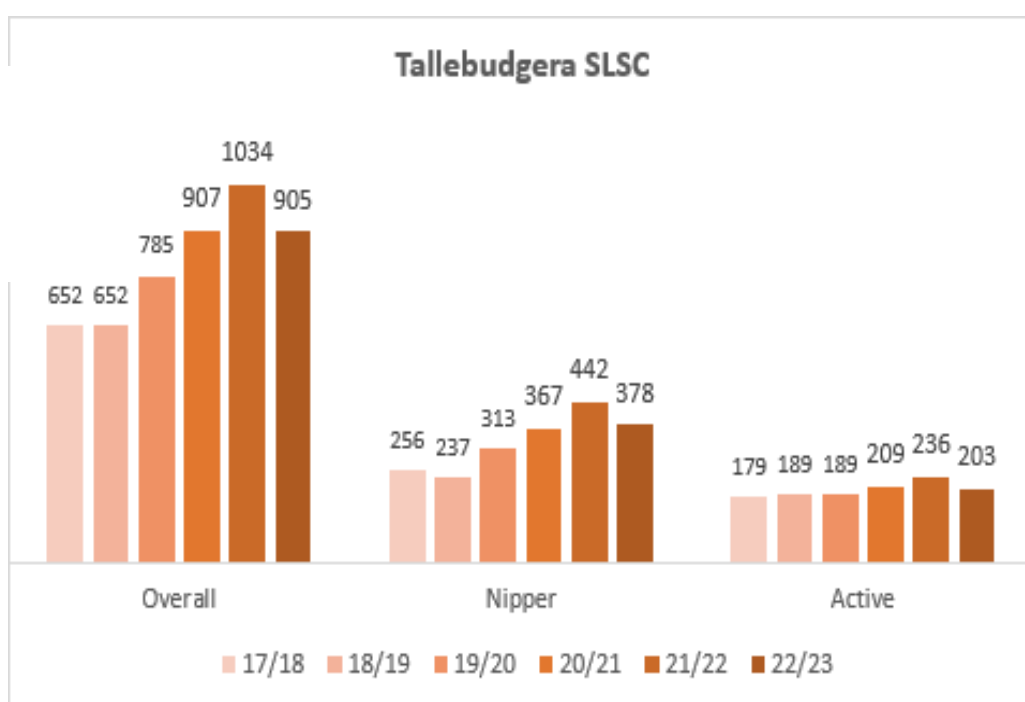

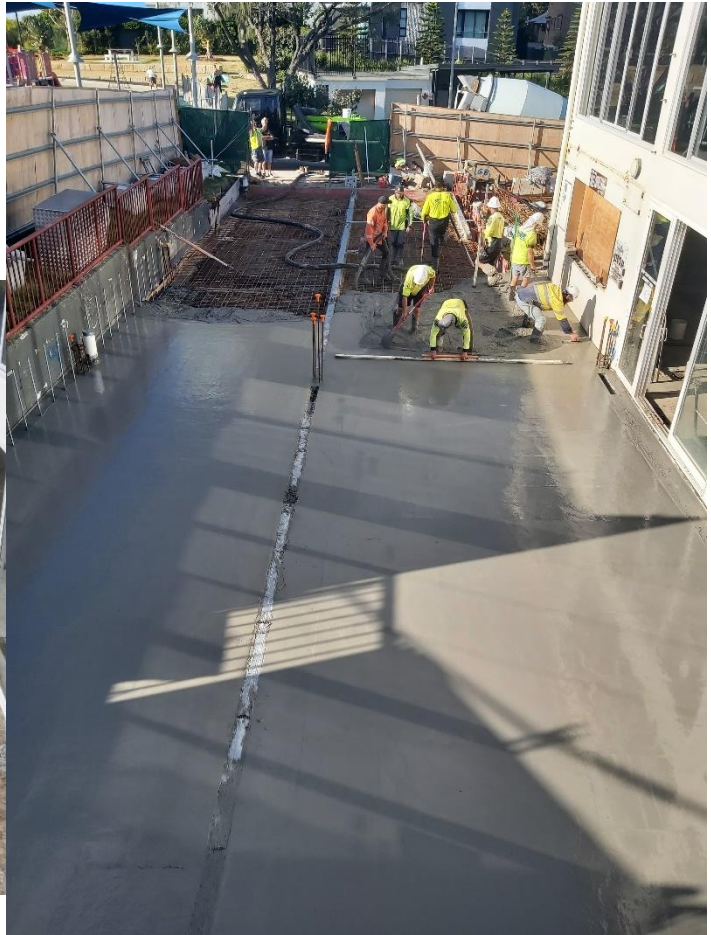

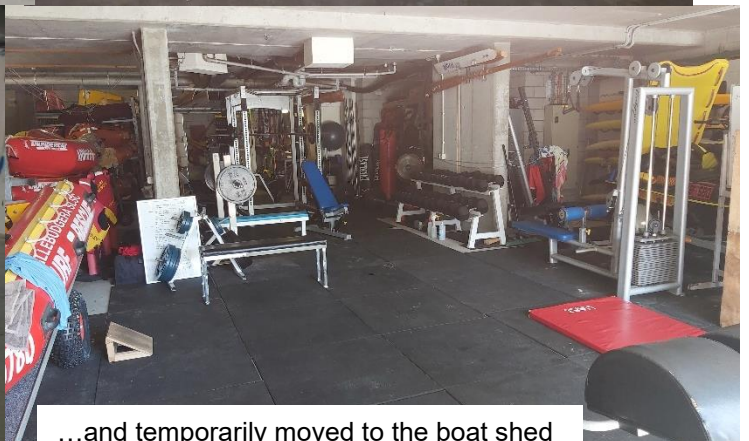
