2023/24 has been another successful patrol season for the patrolling team at Talle. Our volunteers once again, week after week, have given their time to patrol Talle beach in all conditions to provide exemplary commitment to community ensuring that all visitors to our beach return home safely.

It's been a significant team effort this season with 181 patrolling members completing 155 patrols. We had 11 patrol groups this season each doing up to 15 patrols on their roster. Three members patrolled more than 100 hours and 45 members patrolled more than 50 hours on our beach this season. Well done all.

The backbone of our service is provided by our ever reliable Patrol Captains and Vice Captains. Their combined experience and competence from many years of service to Talle and surf lifesaving, in addition to their leadership, guidance and support, sets us up for success.

The foundation of our service is provided by the hardest working training team on the coast ably led by our long serving CTO, Derek, delivering the awards and proficiencies to ensure our members maintain and improve their skills.

This season they trained 17 new Bronze members, 4 SRC members, 4 IRB crew and 5 IRB drivers further reinforcing our patrol and nipper water safety teams, in addition to running 4 proficiencies and running Branch courses. Thanks to Derek, Steve, Jamie, Steve and Richard for another big season.

I wish to acknowledge our supporters club and management committees for their wonderful support again this season, much appreciated. The membership subsidy for members who patrolled more than 25 hours in the previous season and incentives for members to gain awards, for example our youth and patrol captain awards are notable. I also acknowledge the service and support ably provided by our wonderful admin team, Kim and Renee.

The Anzac Day commemoration led by Talle surf boat and lifesaving teams were joined this year by our Nippers and Neptune's RLSC teams. This very special dawn service in the creek was lauded by all in attendance for its simplicity. We had 5 surf boats and 2 IRBs in the water and Talle and Neptune's members on the beach. Richard Pascoe was our MC and ably delivered the Ode of Remembrance. Lest we forget.

We are well set up for continued success in future seasons.

TREASURERS REPORT

This year at Tallebudgera marks another successful season in controlling surf lifesaving in the vicinity of the Club, preserving life and keeping the swimming public safe whilst enhancing our reputation in the community. The Club in recent years has transacted and commenced the process to further building improvement renovations during an unpredictable and challenging construction environment and a very competitive hospitality environment, and this is only possible from the outstanding contribution and dedicated service from all our members, invaluable volunteers, a high performing supporters club, backing by our Bankers (CBA), and strong leadership from our club committee.

Your Club is in a very good financial position and able to meet all its commitments as and when they fall due. It should be noted that your club has made a profit of \$1.608m on the back of rising insurance and rates expenses, a high level of non-cash depreciation expense at \$0.249m (set to increase markedly in future periods once the building improvement renovation works are completed), and increased donations from the Supporters Club which enabled \$1.806m of Renovation Works in Progress to be completed this financial year. The total Project Renovation Works in Progress since commencement stand at \$2.765m. The Club has once again kept our Cash-flow From Operations (a key solvency measure) in excess of \$0.1m at positive \$1.934m (Last Year was positive \$0.834m).

I would like to thank Dermot and Lucy and the Team for their invaluable support in preparing



the monthly accounts, year end audited financial statements, operating budgets and grant activities, and the renovation works in progress.

I would also like to thank our External Auditors “Dickfos Dunn Adam Audit and Assurance” for their professional thoroughness in completing their audit.

I would also like to acknowledge:

- All of our grant providers and sponsors for their contributions to our Life Saving Assets and Equipment to ensure we are able to protect the community and benefit our members;
- The supporters club for not only their financial support and funding of the renovations but also for the Life Saving Equipment provided during the year;
- The Building Committee for their management of the Renovation WIP;

A big thank you to our Club President John Cullen for his unwavering support and contribution to Tallebudgera SLSC and wish him the very best in his retirement.

Most importantly, I acknowledge our members who have made this club the most sought after club on the Gold Coast and encourage you to spread the word once we are fully open for business during the year ahead.

He has done an outstanding job for the club, operating our club through all the disruptions that come with a major renovation.

I'd also like to thank John Cullen for his steady hand and guidance as our club president, John will take a step back next season and will be missed on the committee.

I look forward to seeing you all at the grand opening of our new surf club and thanks again for your support.

The Talle crews started the season with a bang with six crews hitting the water in the early part of the season, but due to sickness and myriad of other reasons the Open men - Tom Cats, Reserve women - Bandits and the sentimental favourites masters men Cab Savs were the only crews to make it to the finish line.

Highlights for the season for the Open men were the Bronze medal at the SLSA Short Course Championships at Swansea Belmont, a National medal mid season is a great motivator and in January they were selected to compete at the Qld state team selection trial, there was to be no State team guernsey this season however it did give them a great lead in to the ASRL Open in February in Lorne Vic.

In March the crew finished in my opinion equal third at the Qld State Championships at North Kirra however the officials saw it as 5th. (I will make it my mission to have finish line cameras at all major events in Qld next season.) The guys also made some other local finals through out the season with good results however the short course bronze medal was the standout result.

The Bandits were a new crew with the all the girls hailing from Emu Park in North Qld, with two of them brand new to the sport and the concept of going backwards through surf. The girls were totally committed from the start and were determined to make their mark for their new club Tallebudgera and also doing Emu Park proud.

Because of the challenges with distance to travel to carnivals the girls were only able to attend 5 carnivals for the season, the best effort no doubt being the top 12 semi final finish at Aussies, a big effort considering the conditions on the day and the lack of training time the girls had in surf leading into the event. They also finished 4th at the Qld State Championships in probably the biggest surf they had seen at that point of the season. I couldn't fault their commitment and ability to overcome their nerves at the time. Well done on a great first year together and the results were outstanding given the obstacles they faced to make it down from Yeppoon for training weekends, carnivals and patrols on Talle beach where they could.

The Cab Savs once again punched above their weight with another very successful season in

Masters punctuated by appearances in the reserve grade competition. A major highlight was winning the ASRL Open in Lorne against the best crews in the country in our division, the result was backed up with a silver medal at the Qld State Championships at North Kirra.

We were out of luck at Aussies though. After winning the first three rounds we were snaked on the line and knocked out in the semi. All in all another great year for the Savs and plenty of laughs and good waves along the way.

A major highlight for the year was POWER'S coming back on board as sponsors of our section. CUB very generously funded the purchase of a new boat for us, not since the early nineties have we had a POWER'S boat in the fleet and its amazing to think we are once again being backed by CUB and such a great brand with a long history and connection with the club.

I can not thank Ian, Zoran, and Trent enough for their combined efforts to make it all happen and the boaties are looking forward to being powered by POWER'S next season.

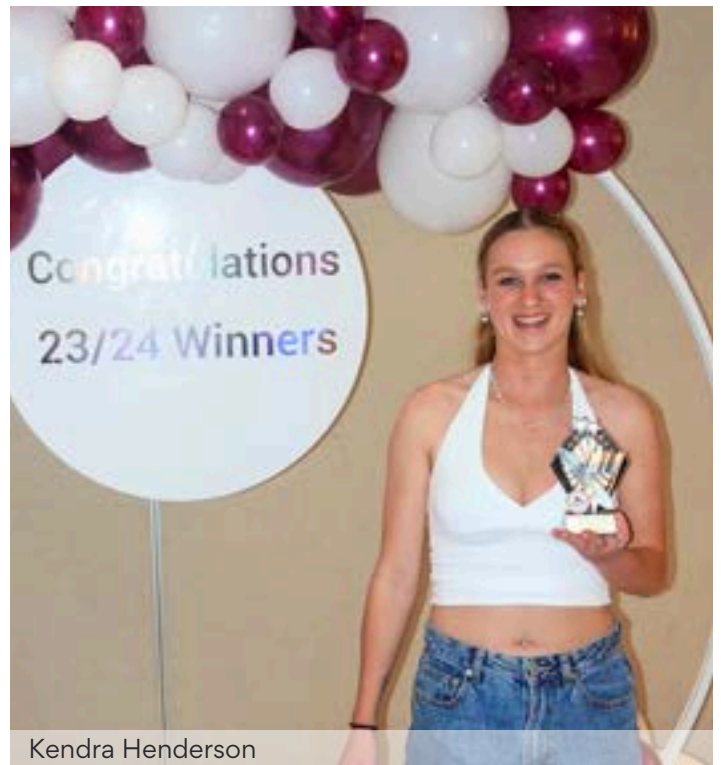
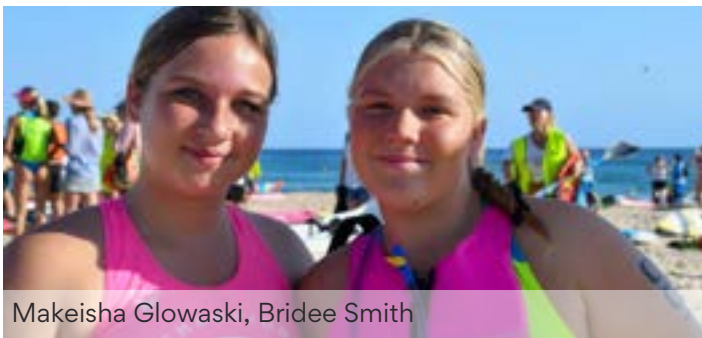

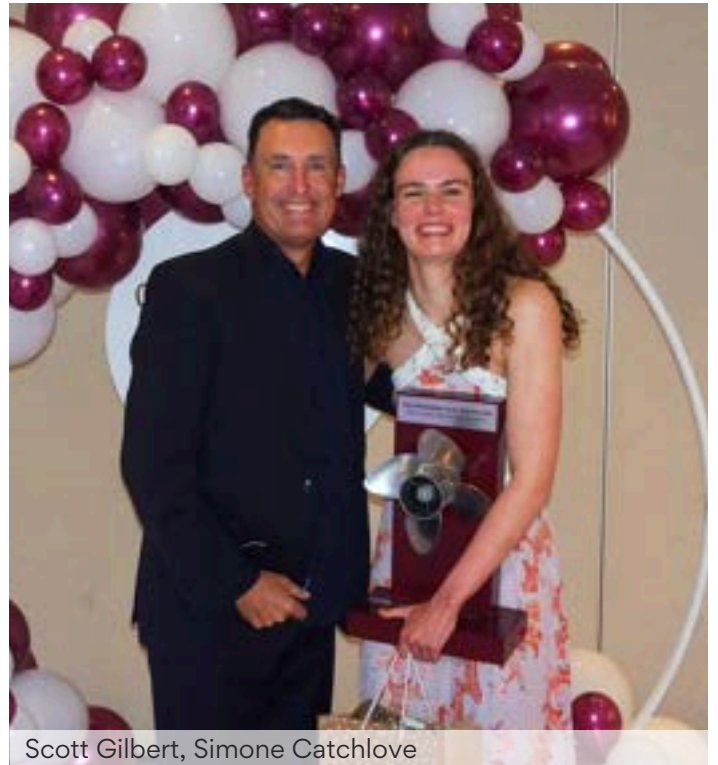

CTO ANNUAL REPORT

A mixed bag for this season. We had our usual 4 Proficiencies, 2 condensed courses-one for SRCs & one for Bronzes & one full course for those inexperienced in the water. We had a couple of Members gain their IRB awards at a Branch-run course in August as well as a couple in February this year. We also managed to squeeze another condensed course for old Bronze Holders who needed to be proficient for Nippers however, the one thing in common with all these courses was processing these members via our new Training Platform “Axcelerate”.

While this platform is certainly a powerful program used by a number of other Registered Training Organisations, it was introduced to us 6 weeks before the start of the season & unceremoniously dumped in our lap with little to no warning & a host of bugs that proved to be very frustrating to navigate. The powers-that-be also finally allowed us to utilise the SRC to Bronze upgrade option (other States had been doing this for at least a season) but did not inform us that by using this option, QLD Students aged 15-17 would not acquire QCE points as it was not regarded as a full course. Then followed a circus of problems trying to transfer these candidates to a full course to earn those points. The crowning glory to this program is you are not credited your award until it is processed rather than when you actually completed the Award. We now have a number of Members who were assessed in October-November but were only processed in the last couple of months.



Branch IRB Course

As always I had very able assistance from Trainers, Jamie, the 2 Steves & Richard followed by assistance from various members of the club for Water Safety, too many to mention here but you know who you are! I cannot praise my Trainers enough-they assist me as well as their Patrols & Nipper Commitments, Family duties, jobs etc & don't get enough recognition from the Club. It is a big step to take & they often do not get thanked for it. Branch is in the process of introducing a trial next season to try & alleviate the time Club Trainers spend at the Club training. Clubs will send their new Members (once they are signed up, financial & have Blue Cards if applicable) to Branch for Induction for a day where they will complete a pool swim if required, gain an Observers & CPR Award at a minimum so that when they return to the Club they are patrol-ready & only need to complete their water sessions to complete their award.

Unfortunately, this will be my last season as CTO as I have gained employment at Branch as Education & Training Supervisor full time. I have enjoyed my 12 seasons but now it's time to hand over to someone else to continue this very important role at the Club. I wish my successor every success & will be in the background to assist if needed. In my new Branch role I will continue to ease the load of our Volunteer Trainers & Assessors, not only for our Club but all Clubs in our Branch. See you on the Beach!

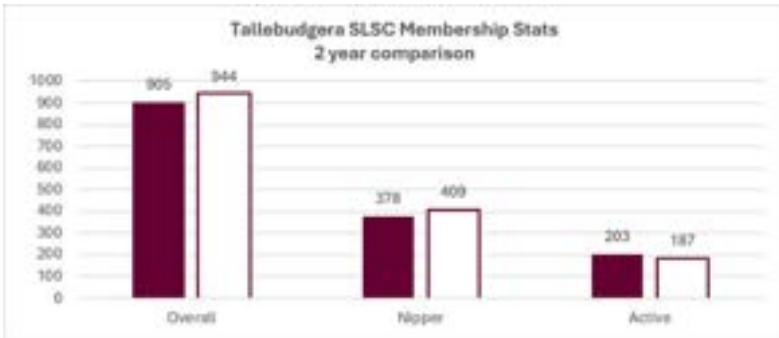


TALLE 2 YEAR AWARD COMPARISON

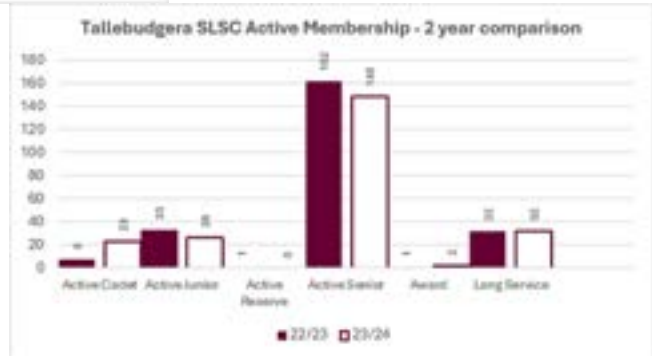



TALLE NIPPER AGE GROUP COMPARISON TO 2022/2023
